

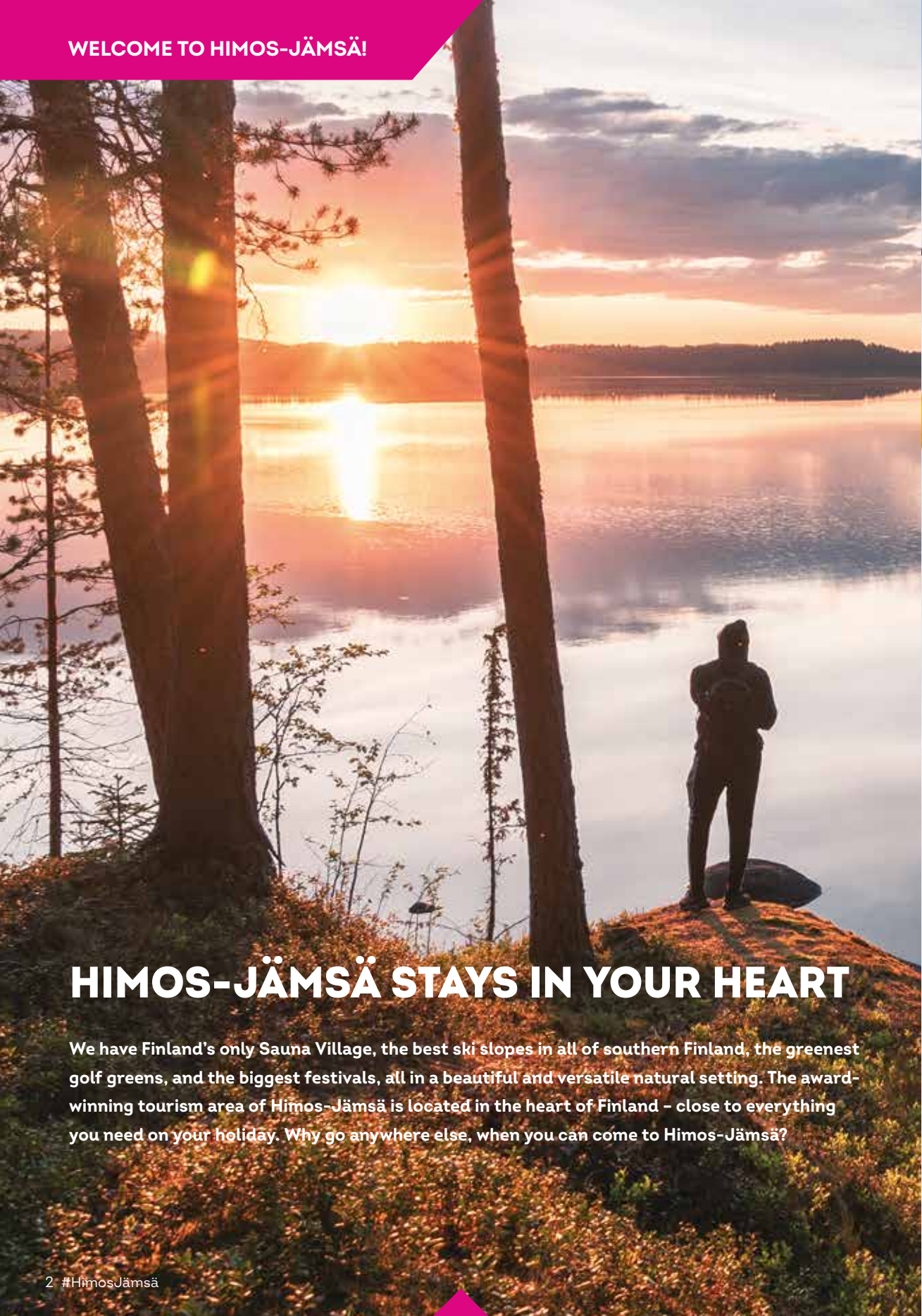

Himos-Jämsä is a winter paradise in Central Finland, offering everything from fast-paced activities to the peace and quiet of nature.

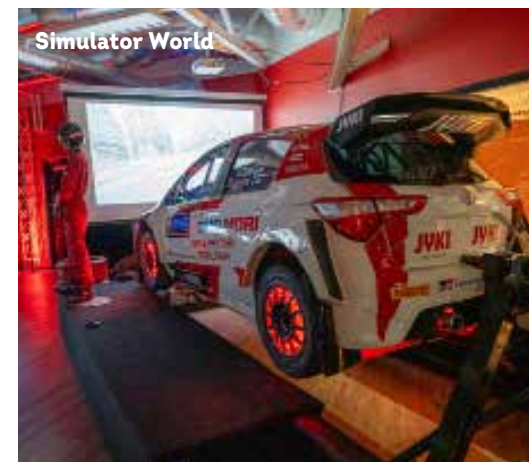
A network of almost 100 kilometres of ski tracks winds its way through the diverse terrain of Himos-Jämsä, dotted with a few charming ski cafés along the way. The lit **First Snow Track** that runs at the foot of West Himos is always a sure sign of the approaching winter.

At Himos, you can go ice skating on the Patalahti Nordic skating track on your own or with a guide. If you strap on a pair of snowshoes, you can enjoy the silence and diversity of nature – even in those hard-to-reach destinations. **Willi Länsi** (Wild West) adds versatility to the range of indoor ac-

tivities at Himos. Leave the winter's frost outside and try a round of glow bowling or padel, or test your skills on the golf and racing simulator!

The weekly programme of **Himos Safaris** includes a wide range of activities from winter swimming adventures to snowmobile and ATV safaris.

Kievari Rantapirtti offers experiences and activities to all tastes – from rally rides to ice carting. On a fresh frosty day, **McAhon Safarit** and **Kievari Rantapirtti**'s dogsled safaris offer an experience that you will not forget.





SLOPES AND WINTER THRILLS FOR EVERYONE

At Himos, visitors can enjoy the services of the largest and most diverse ski resort in Southern and Central Finland. The ski season generally starts in mid-December and continues all the way until May Day.

At best, there are 26 lit slopes and 17 lifts open for visitors. Himos has suitable slopes for both beginners and experienced skiers looking for speed and challenges. Moreover, the Snow Parks of Himos offer versatile areas for all levels of enthusiasts. The easy slopes of HimosLumila are a great place for beginners to practise.

In **HimosLumila**, families can find plenty

of fun activities for the whole day! The area has easy-to-use lifts and smooth downhill slopes suitable for skis, sleds, steerable sleds, and snow tubes. You can enjoy your own picnic snacks at the cozy shelters in the area.

ACTIVITY PARK IN THE HEART OF JÄMSÄ



Over the past few years, the Maaumala activity park has become a fantastic local exercise area, where you can escape the heat of summer by having a swim, play different team sports, and test the outdoor gym equipment.

Located in the Jämsä town centre, the **Maaumala activity park** offers a wide variety of sports and recreational activities. How about a fast-paced ride in the skate park and Pumptrack course, or perhaps a skills-test in the world's first Bukk Off Ice Game Park? You can even enjoy a game of beach volleyball, basketball or pétanque! The swimming beach, sun terrace and playground invite you to spend a lovely summer day in the sun.

In the **Traffic park**, children can have fun while practicing traffic rules with pedal cars, tricycles, and push cars in a realistic traffic environment. The park features

traffic lights, a fueling station, and a roundabout, just like on real roads. The park is easy to stop by from Highway 9, offering a pleasant rest stop for the whole family.



NATURE INVITES YOU TO EXERCISE



Landscapes shaped by the Ice Age and unique nature reserves await the adventurous.

The magnificent ravine valley of **Synninlukko** is an accessible hiking destination. In turn, the **Juveninkoski** waterfall in the village of Partala is the largest waterfall in Central Finland with an impressive height of almost seven metres. **Isojärvi National Park** is an excellent day trip destination, with over 30 km of marked trails of different lengths. The **Rasuanniemi Natura area** winds along the beautiful shoreline of Lake Kankarisvesi. Rasuanniemi is characterised by its numerous, still pristine sandy beaches and coves. Other great hiking destinations include the **Himos trekking routes**, the **Sorvajärvi nature exercise path** near the town centre, the **Pukinvuori hiking route and fitness stairs**, and

the **Tervaleppämetsä** (alder forest) near the shore of the Jämsänjoki river. Many of the trails have a lean-to shelter or campfire site along way.





INDEPENDENT AND GUIDED ACTIVITIES

Jämsä in the summer is full of action and new experiences. The magnificent local nature and countless summer activities are sure to make your days fun.

At **Himos**, you will find an 18-hole **golf course** winding across an area of 118 hectares. Situated in a versatile terrain, this six-kilometre par 72 course is suitable for players of all levels. As a speciality, the course includes an extensive water driving range. You can learn the basics of golf or fine-tune your skills under the guidance of expert teachers.

There are several free **disc golf courses** in Jämsä, which are mostly park-like and easy to navigate. The disc golf park of Lamminsuo offers a great venue for enthusiasts, just a short walk away from the town centre. In Jämsänkoski, Myllymäki DiscGolfPark winding through

a forest is suitable for both recreational and competitive use.



If you are into **padel**, there are outdoor courts available right in the centre of Jämsä. Himos also has two outdoor padel courts with lighting, and the indoor courts of Willi Länsi are available all year round.

Himos Safaris organise interesting activities and a wide variety of things to do throughout the year. The alternatives range from ATV safaris to water activities and mountain biking.

Jämsä also has **the largest paintball range** in all of Finland, along with an **airsoft range** with a trench network that adds new challenges to the game. Situated in the backwoods of Himosvuori hill, the **Hirvikartano Moose Manor Zoo** offers a chance to meet moose up close and personal – and perhaps even get a kiss from one of them! You can also meet fallow deer and reindeer in their natural environment.

WONDERFUL WATERWAYS

Himos-Jämsä is located in the heart of the most beautiful Lakeland Finland. Enjoy a warm summer day at the beach or try some of the numerous water activities Himos-Jämsä has to offer.

The **Maauimala** outdoor swimming pool and the beach at **Lake Särkijärvi** are among the most popular swimming spots in Jämsä. At Jämsänkосki, the beach of **Swimming Hall Koskikara** offers a water slide for kids and a diving platform for thrill-seekers. In turn, the shallow and sandy beach at **Varpaisniemi** is an all-time favourite among families with children. You can also enjoy a hot sauna and tasty café treats in the beautiful surroundings of **Rasua Camping**.

At Himos, holidaymakers can rejuvenate in the waters of **Patalahti Bay** or drop a line to see if the fish are biting. At Koskenpää, you can try to lure in a salmon on the swirling waters of

Survosenkoski rapids. There are several launches on **Pahalampi Pond**, one of which is accessible. Guided fishing trips on Lake Päijänne are organised by **Lucky Fish** and **KJM Sportfishing**. Moreover, **Himos Laketours** and **KerttuElina** offer unforgettable private boat trips on the beautiful Lake Päijänne.



PADDLING ALONG WANHA WITONEN

The Wanha Witonen canoeing route introduces visitors to some of Central Finland's most beautiful nature destinations and cultural attractions.

The 75 km long **Wanha Witonen** canoeing route runs from Petäjävesi to Koskenpää, through Jämsänkосki and the centre of Jämsä, and then all the way to Lake Päijänne. The route also has shorter sections which are suitable for day trips. Along the marked route there are small rapids and chutes as well as lakes and river sections. It is also possible to skirt round the rapids by land, making the route suitable for all skill levels.

You can enjoy your own meals at the waterside resting areas along the route. In addition, you can see various sights along the route, such as the UNESCO World Heritage Site of the Petäjävesi Old

Church, the Aarresaari Local Museum, and the Rasuanniemi Nature Reserve.

Kievari Rantapirtti is conveniently located along the Wanha Witonen canoeing route. From Rantapirtti, you can easily rent a canoe or kayak and order transportation to the starting point of the Wanha Witonen canoeing route. **Marjakki Oy** offers guided paddling tours as well as paddling courses.





SAUNA SOOTHES THE SOUL

Himos-Jämsä belongs to the sauna province of Central Finland, and it is known for its smoke saunas and as the home of the original barrel sauna. In addition, the only Sauna Village in all of Finland can be found right here.

In Himos-Jämsä, you can relax in a variety of different saunas. Each of the rental cabins in the area has a private sauna, and many also have a hot tub or jacuzzi. Even bigger groups can enjoy sauna experiences in the **Sauna Yard of Himos Holiday**. The Yard offers various saunas, outdoor jacuzzis, fireplace lounges, a terrace area, and a grill shelter. The sauna facilities of **Restaurant Rinne** offer an unrivalled way to round up a meeting – sitting in the warmth of an outdoor jacuzzi admiring the magnificent view of the slopes. The world's first barrel sauna can be found in **Kievari Rantapirtti**, and the **Simulator World** has the fastest sauna in Finland, the Ferrari sauna.



Located on the shore of Lake Päijänne in Juokslahti, Jämsä, the **Sauna Village** offers a genuine sauna experience and a journey into the history of the Finnish sauna. At the Sauna Village, guests can visit the world's most extensive collection of Finnish smoke saunas. The oldest smoke saunas in the Sauna Village date back to the 18th century, and the newest represent the smoke sauna construction style of the 1940s.

The smoke saunas introduce visitors to

the history of the Finnish sauna and to the related building traditions. Visitors can enjoy the Finnish sauna culture in the Sauna Village by taking part in the open sauna Saturdays in the summer or by renting a sauna for private use. There is also a grill site for roasting sausages in the Sauna Village. A guided tour of the Sauna Village (in Finnish and English) can be booked in advance.

The Sauna Village offers a unique setting for events and recreational days.

Summer in Himos-Jämsä includes various sports and village events, art exhibitions and summer theatre performances.

Akuliina and **Café Jokiranta's** summer concert series in the center of Jämsä perfectly complements Himos' amazing festival offerings. For many, the summer **markets of Jämsä and Jämsänkoski** are the highlights of the summer. Moreover, sports carnival draw top athletes to the sports field of Paunu.

Every year, Jämsä hosts several special stages of the **World Rally Championships**. Come and take in the Championship spectacle in the legendary rally landscapes of Jämsä!

Horse racing fans always make their way to the annual **Jämsän ravit** (harness racing) event.

In August, the **Paintball Suurpeli** competition takes place, along with the **Youth Jukola orienteering event**. In the winter, the versatile slope events and After Ski at Himos provide fun and excitement for people of all ages. In fact, **Simmarihiihto** (Swimming Suit Skiing) is the most fun skiing event of the year!

ART, THEATRE AND HISTORY

The versatile range of art and theatre experiences in Himos-Jämsä introduces you to the heart of the local culture.



Vinni Cultural Farm

In **Taidetalo Pässinmäki**, there is a permanent art exhibition of the Kauko Sorjonen Foundation collections as well as other rotating exhibitions. **Galleria Vasta** is a great venue for art courses and exhibitions. In the summer, **Pikku Galleria** serves as a summer gallery and the artist's studio. **Vinni Cultural Farm** hosts various cultural events. In addition, Mänttä's famous **Serlachius Art Museum** is only a 40-minute drive away from Jämsä.

The theater scene is vibrant in Jämsä. The diverse programs of **J+J Theatre** and **Teatteri Tenho** feature several premieres each year, providing entertaining moments for both adults and children. In the summer, the summer **theaters of Jämsä and Kuorevesi** bring to the stage laugh-indu-

cing summer plays. Film buffs can head to **Kinotar Cinema**, which shows the latest, most popular films every day.

Set out on a journey to the fascinating museums of the region. Open only in the summer, the **local museums of Aarresaari, Kuorevesi, Längelmäki and Pälämäki** show visitors what rural life was like in the days gone by. The **Farmer's Museum** contains an extensive collection of farming and forestry machines. **Helminauha Toy Museum** displays a total of around 10,000 pieces, including toys from the start of the 20th century until the present day. **Hallinportti Aviation Museum** displays the history of aviation in a diverse manner, ranging from airplanes to smaller items. **Veljekset Karhumäki Ltd** offers a unique collection of aerial photographs since 1929. **Classic Garage** is a private museum full of gems from the automotive history.

Himos offers several slopeside restaurants where skiers can stop for a delicious bite or two. **Restaurant Rinne** invites you to enjoy good food in a relaxing atmosphere. The new bistro-like **Restaurant Saluuna** is loyal to the theme of Wild West and serves a western atmosphere every day. **Restaurant Tupa Kitchen & Bar** offers à la carte options and a hearty breakfast during high season.

Restaurant Patapirtti located near Himos serves delicious local food and wine from their own estate. At **Restaurant Hirvikartano Moose Manor**, you can enjoy delicious game dishes and see the farm's own moose and deer.

Located in the Jämsä town centre, **Bistro&Pub Hilpeä Hirvi** is a laid-back place

for a delicious meal. The **Vanha Mylly** (Old Mill) restaurant is open in the summer in the idyllic surroundings of Jämsänkoski. WARM FELT AND COLOURFUL BEADS

The Jämsä region is known for its unique felt art and handicraft traditions. This rare (by Nordic standards) concentration of companies, craftspeople, and events in the felt industry makes up what is known as the “Felt Valley of Finland”.

The felt centre of Jämsä is found in the village of Partala, where beautiful felt products are manufactured and sold at the felt factory shops of **J. Alho** and **Lahtiset**.

Handicraft shop **Villakka** sells yarn and crafting items, as well as jewellery, interior decoration products and other gift items manufactured by Finnish artisans. At the **KoiDesign shop**, visitors will fall in love with the hand-made silver jewellery and the spectacular items made of deliciously colourful wooden beads. **Pajalan Kenkä** is a veritable treasure trove of shoes, not to mention clothing, bags and many more accessories. The charming 19th century setting of **Witikka-**

lan Kartano (manor) houses a café and a charming lifestyle shop, with a wide variety of brand items and decorative products. The women’s boutique **Putiikki Karderoobi** charms with timeless branded clothing, stylish interior products, and a quality selection of second-hand items. While shopping, customers can take a break in the café corner. **Vehkala’s jeans shop**, famous for its good service, is also worth a visit. **Taikavakka** is many things, including a self-service second hand shop and a natural cosmetics and gift shop. You can find a suitable gift for everyone from **Koskenpään Kammari**.
